User defined caches

You can create user defined caches with c:geo. Those can be used e.g. for planning your own caches as well as just for recording some points of interest. Furthermore c:geo also automatically creates a dedicated user defined cache to store your "Go to" targets.

User defined caches show up with the [cache type indicator](#) of virtual caches in your lists and map.

Create user defined caches

You can create user defined caches in two ways:

1. Open a list of saved caches and select **Manage Caches** → **Create user defined cache** from the [list menu](#).
2. Long click on the map to trigger creation of a user defined cache. This long click function needs to be enabled in [map behavior settings](#).

After performing one of these actions you will be prompted for the title of the user defined caches to be created.
